As we all are facing this new challenge, COVID-19 – we here at Cheyenne County Hospital and Clinic want to share what we are doing to keep staff safe, patients safe and our community safe.

- Our leadership team is meeting daily to stay on top of the daily changes and communicating those with all staff.
- The Clinic is locked down and every patient is screened by the KDHE guidelines. The front entrance of the hospital is open 7 a.m.-5 p.m. Monday-Friday and everyone is screened with the same guidelines. Patients are only allowed one immediate family visitor at a time. No children under 12.
- Call before you come in to the clinic or hospital and if you do come for an appointment at the clinic we ask that you only bring 1 other family member with you.
- Staff are monitoring and recording their temperature at every shift.
- We have 3 ventilators that have been tested and are ready for use if needed.
- We monitor our supply status to be sure we are prepared for the surge in volume later.
- We do have kits to test and a laboratory to send them to. Patients have to meet all criteria to be tested at this time per KDHE.
- Currently there are NO known positive COVID patients in Cheyenne County.
