Cheyenne County Current COVID Vaccination Numbers

The Cheyenne County Health Department is reporting that as of Friday, February 5, 2021, a total of 534 persons have received COVID vaccines in Cheyenne County. Of the 534, they have all receive their first vaccine. Fifty-three of them have also receive their second vaccine. These were all part of the Phase 1 and 2 set forth by Governor Kelly and the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE).

The county continues to wait for additional vaccine to arrive from the state. We will continue to schedule additional vaccination dates as vaccine arrives. We are still in Phase 2, which includes those over 65 years of age, food services, agriculture public workers, childcare workers, school employees, food processing, transportation workers, postal service, and retail workers.

We encourage everyone to get signed up by calling the Cheyenne County Health Department at 785-332-2381 to be placed on the vaccine list. You will be contacted when a vaccine becomes available and/or when your phase will be scheduled. Please continue to be patient as we work with Governor Kelly’s office and KDHE to receive more vaccine and for orders to move to the next phase.
